Saints of the Week




ST. BLAISE

FEAST DAY
FEBRUARY 3

This fourth-century Armenian saint was a bishop and martyr and is venerated as the patron of those who suffer from illnesses of the throat. On his feast day, Catholics traditionally receive a blessing of the throat. During the blessing, the minister takes two candles that were blessed on the feast of the Presentation and makes a cross in front of the throat, saying “Through the intercession of Saint Blaise,

bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness.”

The Blessing of the Throat will take place at St. Charles at the 8:30 AM Mass on Tuesday, February 3rd.



VIRGIN & MARTYR

FEBRUARY 5

Saint Agatha of Sicily (c. 231 – c. 251 AD) is a revered Christian martyr and one of the most celebrated virgin saints in antiquity. Agatha consecrated her virginity to God at a young age. During the persecution of Christians under Emperor Decius, the Roman prefect Quintianus pursued her. When she rejected his advances and marriage proposal, he subjected her to a series of brutal trials, imprisonment, and torture.



ST. PAUL MIKI
&
CAMPANIONS
MARTYRS

In Nagasaki, Japan, February, 1597, 26 martyrs, all united in a common faith and love for Christ and His Church, were crucified on a hill, now known as the Holy Mountain, overlooking Nagasaki. While hanging upon a cross, **St. Paul Miki** preached to the people gathered for the execution. “The only reason for my being killed is that I have taught the doctrine of Christ. I thank God it is for this reason I die. After Christ’s example I forgive my persecutors. I do not hate them. I ask God to have pity on all, and I hope my blood will fall on my fellow men as a fruitful rain.” When missionaries returned to Japan in the 1860’s they found thousands of Christians living around Nagasaki secretly preserving the faith.


Catholic Virtues


