



## Respect Life



Michigan is typical of many states in the last midterm election. They codified a right to abortion up until the moment of birth. What comes next? 

## **END-OFYEAR GIVING**

#### THANK YOU FOR YOUR GENEROSITY TO ST. CHARLES BORROMEO PARISH & SCHOOL

In the last two years of many blessings and challenges it was you who supported our school which provided quality Catholic education to over 300 children in 2021 and 2022. It was you who maintained our Church and services to our St. Charles community! God has blessed us through your gifts of prayer, time, talent, and financial support during the past two years.

Through these gifts – you benefit as well. Financial gifts to our parish and school are tax deductible for those givers who itemize their deductions or, if you do not itemize, you can donate tax free from your IRA directly to St. Charles Borromeo Parish or School. A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows you to give up to \$100,000 from your IRA directly to a charity of your choice when you are over age 70 ½. The donation can be part of your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) or in addition to your RMD!

Yes, the QCD is alive and well! The IRA withdrawal does not count as taxable income making it especially valuable if you're taking the standard deduction rather than itemizing deductions on your tax return. If you file a joint return, your spouse can also have a QCD and exclude up to \$100,000.

**Do not wait.** Call your broker or Financial Advisor now and request they process a QCD check payable to St. Charles Borromeo Parish or School before December 31, 2022. If you have an IRA checkbook you can write a check directly to St. Charles Borromeo Parish or School.

There are also tax advantages for donated stocks, bonds, and mutual funds. If you choose to donate appreciated securities that have been held for more than 12 months, you may receive additional tax benefits.




## How much should I give?
