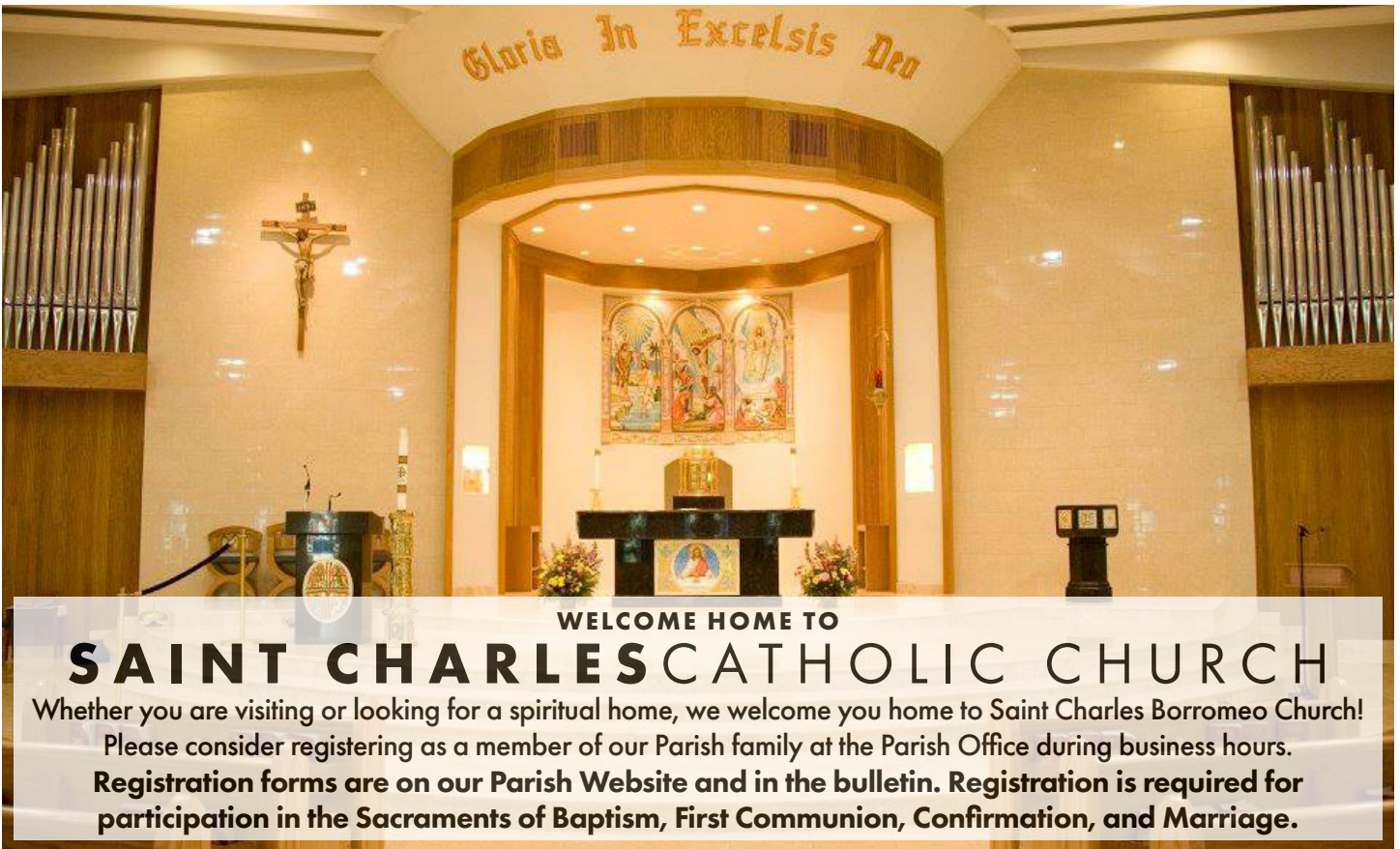

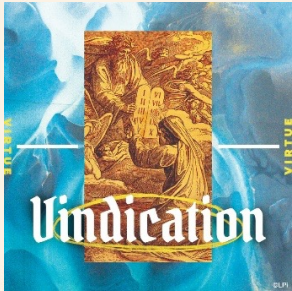

CATHOLIC VIRTUES

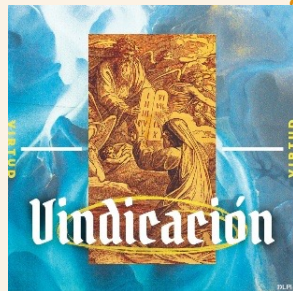


Most commonly, we understand the term “vindication” in a very legal, argumentative context. We say someone is “vindicated” when they are proven innocent, or when their good name is defended from an accusation.

Vindication is related to the virtue of justice, which demands we honor our duty to God and to one another. If we truly put our trust in God and seek to do His will, we may not always have popularity, but we will have truth: “Commit your way to the Lord, trust in him and he will act, and make your righteousness shine like the dawn, your justice like noonday.” (*Psalm 37:5-6*).

VIRTUDES CATÓLICAS

Si realmente confiamos en Dios y buscamos hacer su voluntad, puede que no siempre tengamos popularidad, pero tendremos la verdad: «Encomienda al Señor tu camino; confía en él, y él actuará; hará que tu justicia resplandezca como el alba, y tu derecho como el mediodía» (*Salmo 37:5-6*).

Celebrating Children



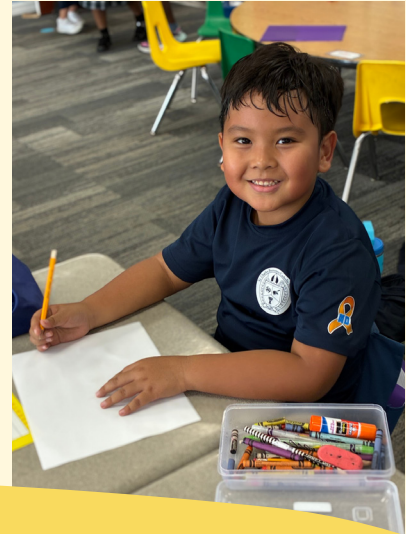
Dear Parents of our young parishioners,

† GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION FOR CATHOLICS

Catholics fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when they receive Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ's commandment to eat His Body and drink His Blood. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, communicants should not be conscious of grave sin, have fasted for an hour, and seek to live in charity and love with their neighbors. Persons conscious of grave sin must first be reconciled with God and the Church through the sacrament of Penance. A frequent reception of the sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

FOR OTHER CHRISTIANS

We welcome to this celebration of the Eucharist those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a consequence of the sad divisions in Christianity that we cannot extend to them a general invitation to receive Communion. Catholics believe that the Eucharist is an action of the celebrating community signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray.

FOR THOSE NOT RECEIVING COMMUNION

Those not receiving sacramental Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with our Lord Jesus and with one another.

FOR NON-CHRISTIANS

We also welcome to this celebration those who do not share our faith in Jesus. While we cannot extend to them an invitation to receive Communion, we do invite them to be united with us in prayer.

FLAG DAY

Flag Day, observed annually on June 14, commemorates the day in 1777 when the Continental Congress officially adopted the "Stars and Stripes" as the national flag of the United States.

After decades of lobbying by individuals and patriotic societies, President Woodrow Wilson issued the first presidential proclamation establishing June 14 as National Flag Day.

While widely celebrated, Flag Day was not officially a permanent national observance until August 3, 1949, when Congress approved the national holiday and President Harry S. Truman signed it into law.

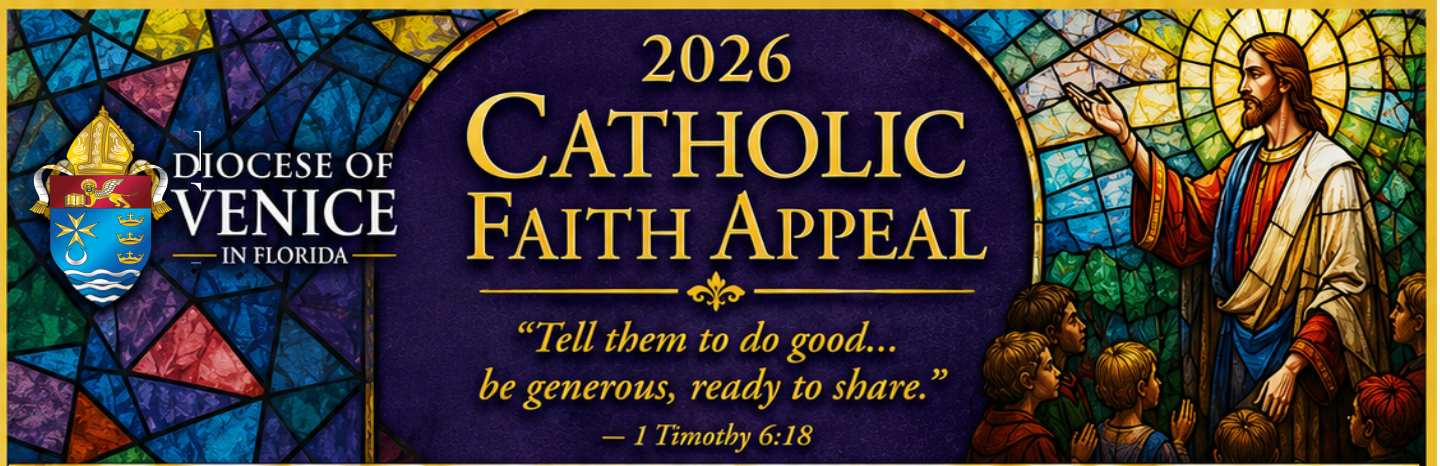

THE MARRIAGE TRIBUNAL

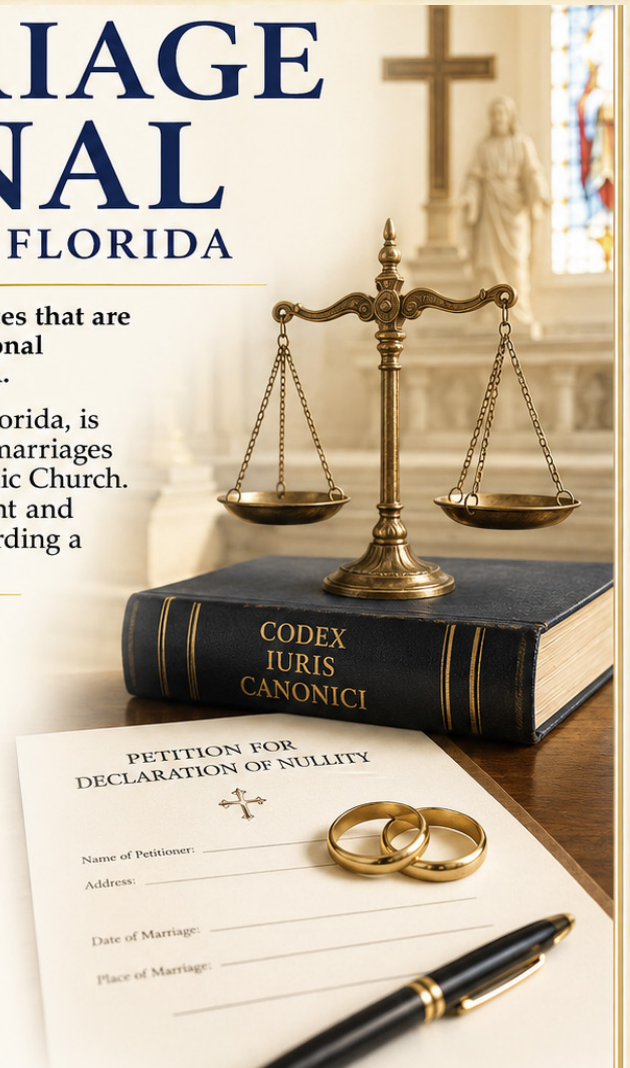
DIOCESE OF VENICE, FLORIDA

For several weeks you have read about the many services that are funded by the Catholic Faith Appeal. There are additional Administrative Offices that are also funded by the CFA.

The Marriage Tribunal for the Diocese of Venice, Florida, is a church court that investigates the validity of previous marriages to determine if a couple is free to marry within the Catholic Church. It processes annulment applications—evaluating consent and canonical form—to issue formal, pastoral decisions regarding a person’s marital status.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACTIVITIES:

-  • **ANNULMENT INVESTIGATIONS:** Processes Formal Cases, Lack of Canonical Form, and Privilege of Faith cases to determine if a valid marriage bond was formed.
-  • **CASE PROCESSING:** Assigns judges (appointed by the Bishop) to review cases, examine evidence, and take witness testimonies.
-  • **RESPONDENT RIGHTS:** Ensures the former spouse (Respondent) is contacted, notified of the process, and given the opportunity to participate.
-  • **PASTORAL GUIDANCE:** Operates to determine the truth of a union, rather than assigning blame, while providing spiritual pastoral care.
-  • **DOCUMENTATION:** Provides necessary forms, including, but not limited to, Application for Declaration of Nullity and Affidavit Concerning the Freedom to Marry.
