





WELCOME FATHER GREGG KLICH




My name is Fr. Gregg (Grzegorz) Klich. I was born in Poland in 1982 and graduated from seminaries in Poland and in Michigan.





The turnaround is that fast and is that constant.


The next blood drive will be **May 3rd**.






Saints of the Week




St. Fabian was a Pope (236-250 AD), is remembered as a strong administrator and a courageous martyr who solidified the early Roman Catholic Church's structure during a period of relative peace before facing intense persecution.




St. Sebastian (c. 255-288 AD) secretly joined the Roman army to aid persecuted Christians. When his Christianity was discovered, Emperor Diocletian ordered him tied to a stake and shot with arrows. He survived this and returned to the Emperor to publically denounce his cruelty to Christians. He was beaten to death with clubs.



St. Agnes was martyred at the age of 12 or 13. She dedicated her life to God and rejected many suitors. On her feast day, January 21, two lambs are blessed at the Basilica of Sant'Agnese and their wool is used to weave the pallium, a vestment the Pope gives to new archbishops.




St. Vincent was known for his unwavering faith during the Roman persecution under Emperor Diocletian around 304 AD. He is honored as Spain's first martyr and the patron of winegrowers and Portugal.



St. Marianne Cope (1838-1918) dedicated 35 years of her life to caring for leprosy (Hansen's disease) patients in Hawai'i. Her feast day is January 23 (her birthday). Before going to Hawai'i she helped found two of the first general hospitals in New York: St. Elizabeth's in Utica and St. Joseph's in Syracuse. She was canonized on

October 21, 2012 by Pope Benedict XVI, becoming the 11th American citizen so honored.



St. Francis de Sales (1567-1622) played a major role in the Counter-Reformation, successfully bringing many Calvinists back to the Catholic Church by preaching and by distributing numerous pamphlets. His feast day is January 24.

His most famous books are still in print: *Introduction to the Devout Life* and *A Treatise on the Love of God*.


