



We have been very blessed through your gifts of prayer, time, talent, and treasure! We continue to strive to assist with the many needs presented due to the economic times in which we find ourselves.

Through these gifts – you benefit as well. Financial gifts to our parish and school are tax deductible for those givers who itemize their deductions or, if you do not itemize, you can donate tax free from your IRA directly to St. Charles Borromeo Parish or School. A Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) allows you to give up to \$108,000 from your IRA directly to a charity of your choice when you are over age 70 ½. The donation can be part of your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) or in addition to your RMD! The RMD age is 73 years through 2032.

Yes, the QCD is alive and well! The IRA withdrawal does not count as taxable income making it especially valuable if you're taking the standard deduction rather than itemizing deductions on your tax return. If you file a joint return, your spouse can also have a QCD and exclude up to \$100,000.

Do not wait. Call your broker or Financial Advisor now and request they process a QCD check payable to St. Charles Borromeo Parish or School before December 31, 2025. If you have an IRA checkbook you can write a check directly to St. Charles Borromeo Parish or School.

There are also tax advantages for donated stocks, bonds, and mutual funds. If you choose to donate appreciated securities that have been held for more than 12 months, you may receive additional tax benefits.

You may have considered naming St. Charles Borromeo in your Will, but did you know you could also name St. Charles Borromeo Parish or School as a beneficiary on your IRA or 401k? There are great tax advantages for you and your family while blessing St. Charles Borromeo with this kind of gift.
