

Our neighbors in Canada have an odd view on the sanctity of life. Prime Minister Trudeau recently responded to the Uvalde, TX mass murder by outlawing all transactions involving the sale of firearms including handguns. But earlier in May, the PM announced that pro-abortion groups in the country would get millions of dollars from his government to promote the murder of the unborn. Abortion clinics are every bit as capable as guns in ending a life.

Meanwhile, Canadian legislators are trying to be precise about how the mentally ill can participate in their Medical Aid in Dying effort (MaiD). Doctors are struggling with exactly how an incompetent person can petition for assisted suicide. Are you ever surprised by tragic events caused by people raised in our culture?







Your donation to the CFA helps fund important and needed programs throughout the Diocese of Venice in addition to giving this department the resources needed to provide these victims with a way out.




