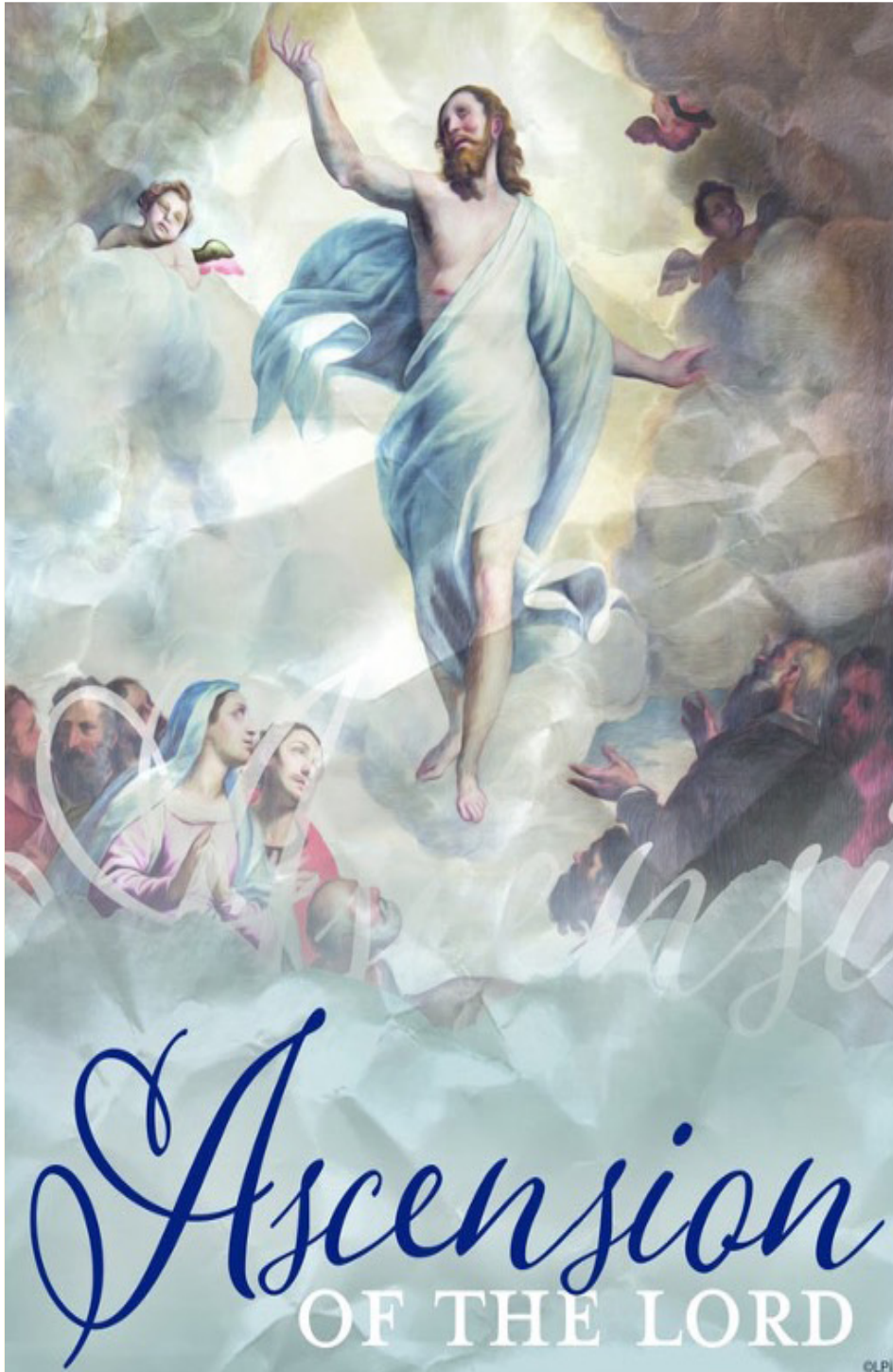

For several weeks you have read about the many services that are funded by the Catholic Faith Appeal. There are additional Administrative Offices that are also funded by the CFA. The Chancellor of the Diocese of Venice in Florida is a high-ranking Diocesan official, who serves as the chief notary and record-keeper, ensuring all canonical acts of the Diocese are organized and preserved. They assist the Bishop in overseeing administration, ensuring Diocesan policies are followed, and serving as a representative to Diocesan entities.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES INCLUDE:

-  **ARCHIVIST/NOTARY:** Gathering, arranging, and safeguarding the Acts and archives of the Diocesan curia.
-  **ADMINISTRATION:** Assisting the Bishop in the administration of Catholic Center departments.
-  **CLERGY MATTERS:** Assisting with clergy communications, including notifications of passing, funeral arrangements, and administrative protocols.
-  **CERTIFICATION:** Certifying the “good standing” of priests for assignment, which includes verifying backgrounds and training.
-  **REPRESENTATION:** Serving on various boards and committees.

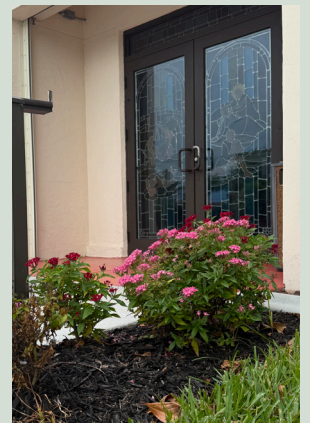
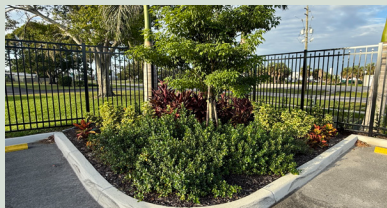
DEVELOPMENT AT 20 WEEKS

The baby responds to sounds by moving or increasing their pulse.



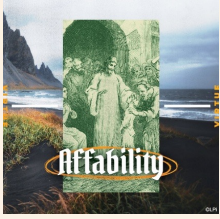

CATHOLIC VIRTUES

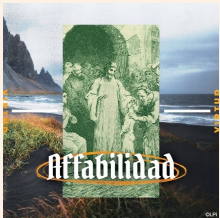

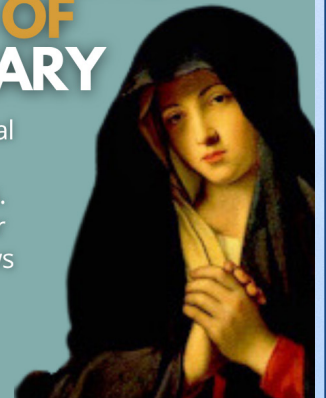

UNDERSTANDING THE SACRAMENTS



BAPTISM

Baptisms are celebrated on the last Saturday of the month. Parents should contact our Faith Formation Office at least six weeks before the anticipated Baptism to register for the Baptism preparation class at (941) 585-0668 or via email at faithformation@stcbc.org.

THE RITE OF ANOINTING

A person **does not** need to wait until the point of death to receive this sacrament. For those who are about to depart from this life, the Church offers the person Penance, Anointing of the Sick, and the Eucharist as Viaticum (food for the journey) given at the end of life. Contact the Parish Office at (941) 625-4754 to schedule an anointing.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are a registered parishioner of St. Charles Borromeo Church and plan to marry in our parish, please contact the Office of Faith Formation at (941) 585-0668 at least six months prior to the tentative wedding date.

CONVALIDATION OF MARRIAGES

Were you married outside of the Catholic Church? Don't hesitate to contact the Office of Faith Formation at (941) 585-0668 or faithformation@stcbc.org to make arrangements to have your marriage blessed by one of our priests.

DIVORCED OR SEPARATED

Don't let a separation or a legal divorce keep you from the life of the Church. Please contact the Parish Office at (941) 625-4754 to speak to a priest about your own marital situation.

ANNULMENT

An annulment is more accurately described as a declaration of matrimonial invalidity. If you wish to reestablish your freedom to marry in the Church, please contact your parish priest for assistance.

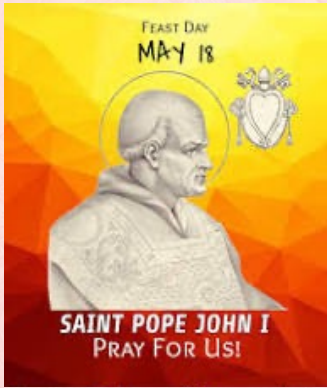

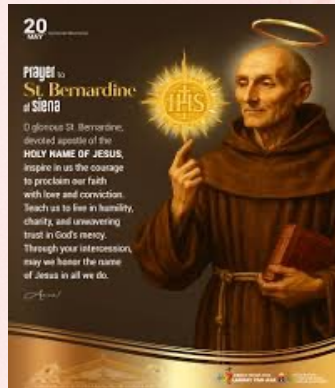


Saints of the Week



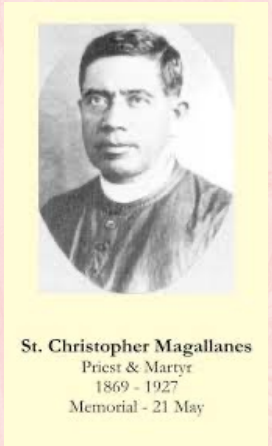
Saint Pope John I (c. 470–526) was Pope from 523 to 526. He served as the 53rd pope and was the first Pope to travel to Constantinople, the capital of the Byzantine Empire, while in office. The Pope’s visit also brought about the reconciliation of the Eastern and Western Churches which had been

plagued by a schism since 482. He was arrested and died while imprisoned in Ravenna and is honored as a martyr by the Catholic Church.



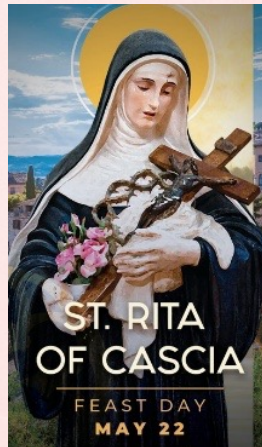
Saint Bernardine of Siena (1380–1444), known as the “Apostle of Italy,” was a renowned Franciscan priest and missionary. He is most famous for his powerful, populist preaching style and his deep devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus. He popularized the IHS symbol (the first

three letters of the name of Jesus in Greek) surrounded by a blazing sun. He traveled throughout Italy on foot, attracting massive crowds of up to 30,000 people. His feast day is celebrated on May 20, the anniversary of his death.



Saint Christopher Magallanes (1869–1927) was a Mexican priest and martyr who was killed during the Cristero War. He is often commemorated alongside 24 other martyrs—mostly priests and a few laymen—who died during the anti-Catholic persecution in Mexico under President Plutarco Calles. After the government closed official seminaries, he opened a secret one in his parish to

continue training priests. Though accused of inciting rebellion, he actually preached against armed conflict, encouraging peaceful resistance. His last words were: “I die innocent, and ask God that my blood may serve to unite my Mexican brethren.”



Saint Rita of Cascia (1381–1457) is a beloved Italian saint widely known as the Patroness of Impossible Causes. Her life story is celebrated for its themes of extreme patience, forgiveness, and resilience through every state of life—as a wife, mother, widow, and eventually an Augustinian nun. Shortly before her death in the dead of winter, Rita asked for a rose from her former home. Miraculously, a

single rose was found blooming in the frozen garden, leading to the tradition of blessing roses on her feast day.

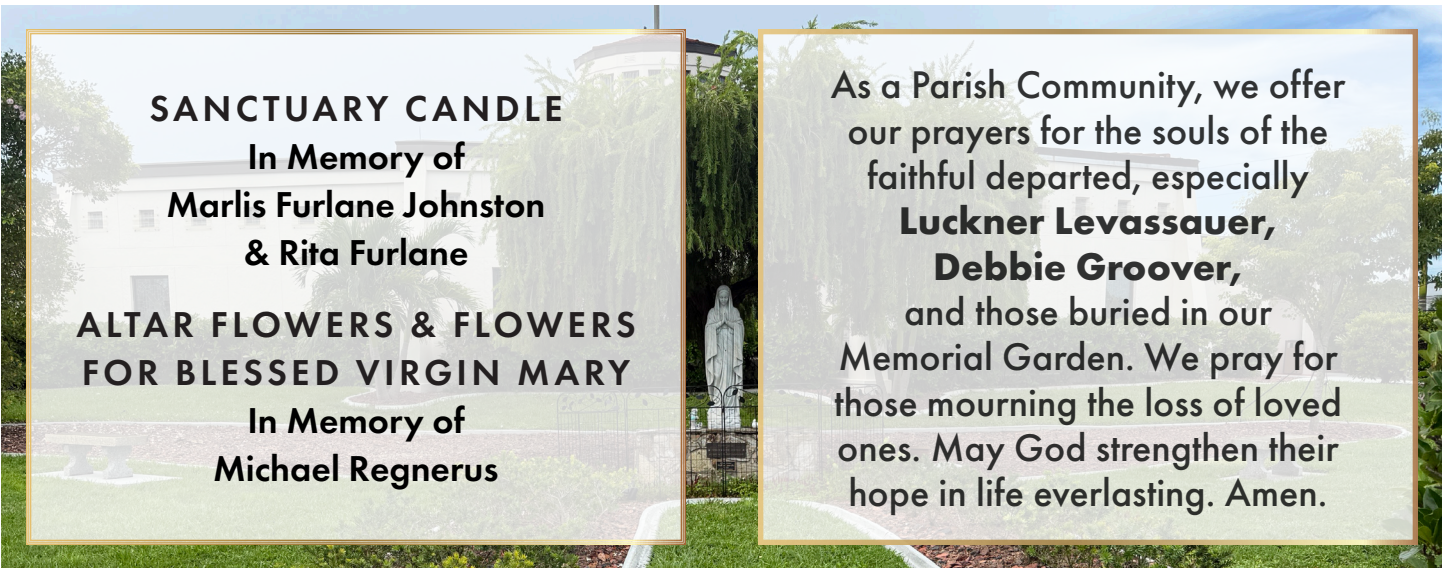
