





### FOUNDER OF THE TRUE CROSS St. Helena – Mother of Roman Emperor Constantine

In 326 AD, the devout Christian Saint Helena, at the age of 80, traveled to the Holy Land to visit important Christian sites. Guided by an elderly Jew with inherited knowledge, **Helena found the spot where Christ was crucified.** 

Under her sponsorship, workers excavated the area, uncovering three wooden crosses at the foot of Golgotha. To distinguish the True Cross from the other two, Helena had a sick person touch each cross. When a sick woman touched the third cross, she was instantly healed, thereby identifying the True Cross.

After finding the True Cross and other relics of the Passion, Helena brought them back to Rome, where she placed them in a special chapel that was part of an imperial palace. This location eventually became the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem in Rome.

Saint Helena had a church built on the original site of Jesus' crucifixion, burial, and resurrection, known as the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Her son Constantine dedicated this church on September 13-14 in 335 A.D.

The Church has a long tradition of venerating the Cross, which is why Catholic and Eastern Orthodox churches always have large crucifixes in prominent places. It is also why Catholic Christians and Eastern Christians keep crosses and crucifixes in their homes, usually on their wall or above their doorway. In fact, a cross or a crucifix put in a place of honor is a sure mark of a Christian home.


### Saints of the Week



We celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows on September 15. It commemorates the profound union of heart that existed between the

Mother of the Redeemer and the Savior, through which she experienced many interior sorrows as a consequence of His Mission, but particularly during His Passion and Death.

Saints Cornelius and Cyprian were two third-century Christian leaders who were martyred for their faith. As Pope and Bishop, respectively, they were close allies who guided the church through severe Roman persecution and a major internal schism over the readmission of lapsed Christians.






St. Robert Bellarmine (1542–1621) was an Italian Jesuit priest, cardinal, and one of the most distinguished theologians of the Counter-Reformation. A Doctor of the Church, he was a prolific writer and a

powerful defender of Catholic doctrine against Protestantism. His life was marked by immense learning, personal piety, and active service to the Church.

Saint Hildegard of Bingen (c. 1098–1179) was a German Benedictine abbess, mystic, writer, and composer who became one of the most influential and knowledgeable person of the High Middle Ages. Also known as the "Sibyl of the Rhine," she was canonized and named a Doctor of the Church in 2012, an honor reserved for saints with exceptional contributions to Catholic theology. Her Feast day is September 17th.





Saint Januarius (also known by his Italian name, San Gennaro) was an early Christian bishop of Benevento, Italy, and is the patron saint of Naples, Italy. He is believed to have been martyred during the persecution of Christians by the Roman Emperor Diocletian around 305 A.D. He is most famous for the recurring "miracle of the blood" in Naples, where a vial of his dried blood is said to liquefy multiple times a year.



Saints Andrew Kim Taegon and Paul Chong Hasang, and their companions are 103 martyrs who were executed for their Catholic faith in 19th-century Korea. They were canonized by Pope John Paul II in 1984 during his visit to South Korea. The feast day for the Korean Martyrs is September 20.




# Inspiring the Next Generation of Faith



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the violent conflict in Gaza continues, a grave humanitarian crisis is unfolding, with many Christians and innocent people struggling to survive. With this devastating situation in

mind, I write to you in appeal for our brothers and sisters in need in the midst of these destructive events.

The Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, has expressed his concern with the situation, saying, "I am following with great concern the dire humanitarian situation in Gaza, where the civilian population is suffering from severe hunger and remains exposed to violence and death." Our Catholic Faith calls each of us to care for those in need, and, at this time in particular, for those who are suffering in the wake of this ongoing tragedy.

Recognizing the need of those who have been so severely impacted by the conflict in the region, the President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has asked Dioceses throughout the country to take up a special collection to assist with humanitarian aid in Gaza. Within the Diocese of Venice, the collection will be taken on the weekend of September 20-21, 2025.

Your generosity and your prayers for the people of Gaza are deeply appreciated. May Almighty God bless you and your families. Please continue to pray for peace throughout the world, particularly in the Middle East.

### GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION

#### FOR CATHOLICS

Catholics fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when they receive Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ's commandment to eat His Body and drink His Blood. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, communicants should not be conscious of grave sin, have fasted for an hour, and seek to live in charity and love with their neighbors. Persons conscious of grave sin must first be reconciled with God and the Church through the sacrament of Penance.

A frequent reception of the sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

#### FOR OTHER CHRISTIANS

We welcome to this celebration of the Eucharist those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a consequence of the sad divisions in Christianity that we cannot extend to them a general invitation to receive Communion. Catholics believe that the Eucharist is an action of the celebrating community signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray.


#### FOR THOSE NOT RECEIVING COMMUNION

Those not receiving sacramental Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with our Lord Jesus and with one another.

#### FOR NON-CHRISTIANS


