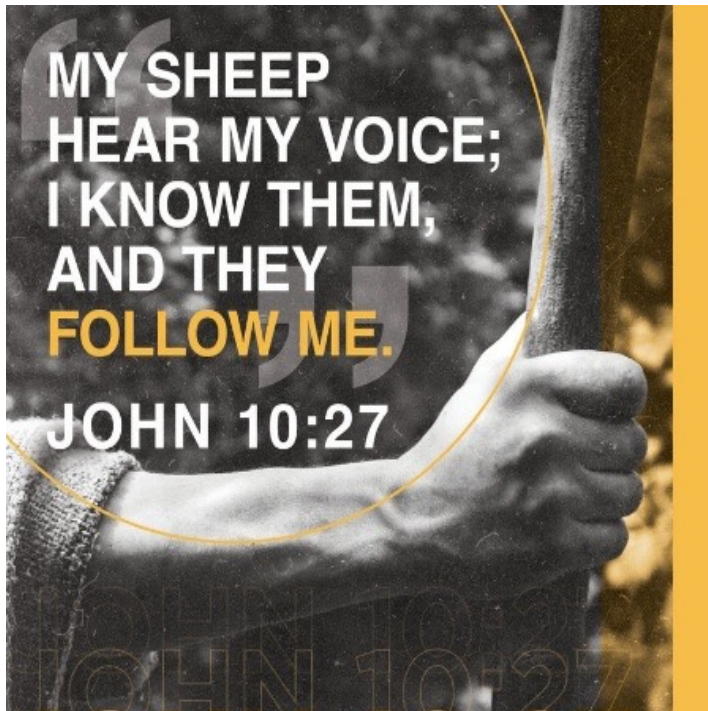

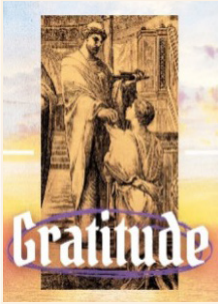

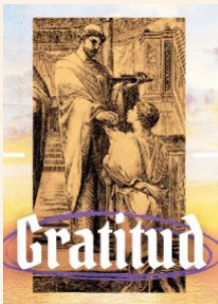

## CATHOLIC VIRTUES



Gratitude is about more than just attitude. This virtue concerns our actions — how we carry ourselves in the world, how we behave toward other people, and how we submit to lawful authority. We owe gratitude to those who have cared for us — children owe it to their parents in the form of respect and citizens owe it to their country in the form of love and service. The Eucharist is the most perfect act of gratitude. Appropriately, Jesus “gives thanks” for the bread at the Last Supper, just as we give thanks before the Eucharist — acknowledging God as the principal source of all that is good.

## VIRTUDES CATÓLICAS

## GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION

### FOR CATHOLICS

Catholics fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when they receive Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ’s commandment to eat His Body and drink His Blood. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, communicants should not be conscious of grave sin, have fasted for an hour, and seek to live in charity and love with their neighbors. Persons conscious of grave sin must first be reconciled with God and the Church through the sacrament of Penance. A frequent reception of the sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

### FOR OTHER CHRISTIANS

We welcome to this celebration of the Eucharist those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a consequence of the sad divisions in Christianity that we cannot extend to them a general invitation to receive Communion. Catholics believe that the Eucharist is an action of the celebrating community signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray.

### FOR THOSE NOT RECEIVING COMMUNION

Those not receiving sacramental Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with our Lord Jesus and with one another.

### FOR NON-CHRISTIANS

We also welcome to this celebration those who do not share our faith in Jesus. While we cannot extend to them an invitation to receive Communion, we do invite them to be united with us in prayer.

# CHURCH ETIQUETTE

**ATTIRE** The idea of Sunday best should be honored; churchgoers of all ages should dress conservatively. Coat and tie is appropriate for men, but not required. Women should wear modest dresses, skirts and slacks; no tank tops, short skirts or tight-fitting clothing.

**QUIET TIME** Turn off cell phones and pagers. It is understandable that children may have difficulty sitting quietly, but when they become distracting, take them out briefly until they settle down. They may simply need a change of environment. The Narthex is an appropriate place to take them.

**ARRIVAL** Offering envelopes should be prepared ahead of time. Arrive at least 10 minutes before Mass begins. This helps reduce distractions and provides time to get settled. Latecomers should wait to be seated by ushers so as not to disrupt the Mass and the congregation. Please avoid chewing gum or eating candy when coming to Mass.

**ENTERING THE CHURCH** Once you enter the Church, please refrain from over socializing with others. Remember that others are already engaged in prayer in their seats. It is optional to bless yourself with holy water, but as a sign of respect for the Blessed Sacrament, genuflect (bow if you are unable to genuflect) before taking your seat. Move to the center of the pew to accommodate others who arrive after you.

**SIGN OF PEACE** People usually shake hands or exchange a quick kiss, but if you have a cold or cough, you can politely say, "Peace be with you," without shaking hands.

**CONSECRATION** Elevation of the Host and Chalice after the words of consecration are spoken is a sacred time, and there should be silent reverence with no movement around the church, except in an emergency.

**COMMUNION** Again, please refrain from socializing when leaving the pew to receive Communion. Receive the holy Eucharist with reverence, bow slightly and respond "Amen."

**LEAVING THE CHURCH** The final part of Mass is singing a closing hymn. Leaving before the hymn ends is inappropriate. Genuflect (or bow) toward the altar before leaving. Refrain from greeting and visiting each other until leaving the church. Have respect for those who wish to remain in prayer.

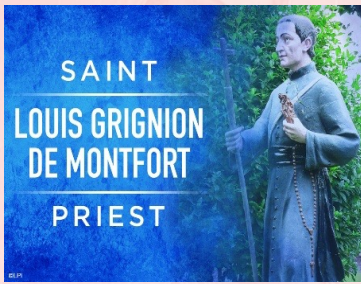

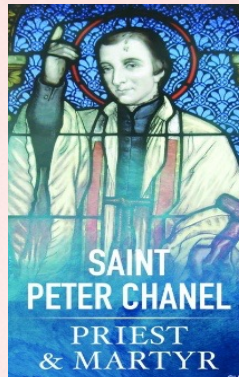

# Saints of the Week



**St. Louis Grignon de Montfort (1673-1716)**  
His preaching, attracted thousands of people back to the faith. Father Louis recommended frequent, even daily, Holy Communion (not the custom then) and imitation of the Virgin Mary's ongoing acceptance of God's will for her life. His book True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin has become a classic explanation of Marian devotion. Saint Louis died in Saint-Laurent-sur-Sèvre, where a Basilica has been erected in his honor. He was canonized in 1947. His feast day is April 28.

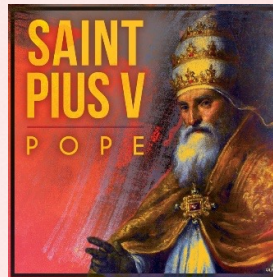


**St. Peter Chanel (1803-1841)**  
Wanting to be a missionary, he joined the Society of Mary, the Marists, at 28. As superior of seven Marists, he traveled to an island, Fortuna, in Western Oceania. Saint Peter Chanel struggled with a new language and mastered it, making the difficult adjustment to life with whalers, traders, and warring natives. Despite little apparent success and severe want, he maintained a serene and gentle spirit, plus endless patience and courage. A few natives had been baptized, a few more were being instructed. When the chieftain's son asked to be baptized, persecution by the chieftain reached a climax. Father Chanel was clubbed to death. Within two years after his death, the whole island became Catholic and has remained so. He was canonized by Pope Pius XII in 1954. His feast day is April 28.

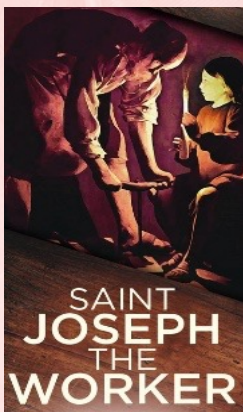


**Saint Catherine of Siena (1347–1380)** was an Italian lay Dominican, mystic, and Doctor of the Church. Despite having no formal education, she was a savvy diplomat who wrote hundreds of letters to leaders, urging Pope Gregory XI to return the papacy to Rome in 1377. Her writings are considered masterpieces of Italian literature and Catholic theology, leading to her designation as a Doctor of the Church. She is said to have received the wounds of Christ (stigmata), which were invisible during her life at her request, becoming visible only after her death. Her feast day is April 29.

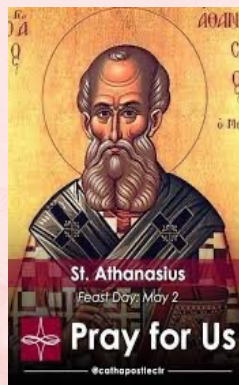
St. Catherine was renowned for her courage to "speak truth to power," holding leaders accountable and promoting peace during a turbulent period of plague and political conflict.



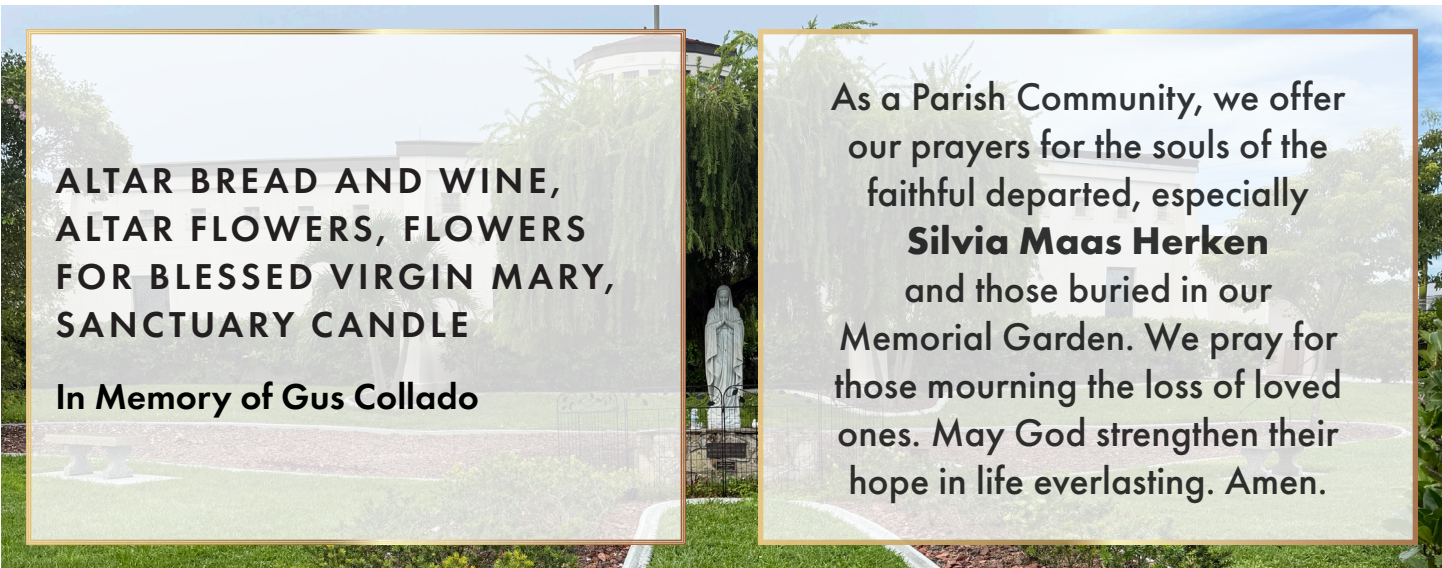
**Pope St. Pius (1504-1572)**  
The feast day of St. Pius V is celebrated on April 30, a Dominican friar known for implementing the Council of Trent reforms, standardizing the Roman Missal, and promoting the rosary after the Battle of Lepanto. He is known as the "Pope of the Rosary" and a key figure in the Counter-Reformation. A Dominican friar before his election, he continued to wear his white habit as Pope, establishing the tradition of the white papal cassock still worn today.



**Saint Joseph the Worker** is the patron saint of workers, whose feast day is celebrated on May 1. This title emphasizes the dignity of human labor and Joseph's role as a humble carpenter who provided for the Holy Family. This day was established by Pope Pius XII in 1955 to coincide with International Workers' Day (May Day) which was sponsored by Communists. It offered a Christian perspective on labor.



**St. Athanasius (c.296-373)**  
led a tumultuous but dedicated life of service to the Church. He was the great champion of the faith against the widespread heresy of Arianism, the teaching by Arius that Jesus was not truly divine. The vigor of his writings earned him the title of Doctor of the Church. Five times Athanasius was exiled for his defense of the doctrine of Christ's divinity. During one period of his life, he enjoyed 10 years of relative peace—reading, writing, and promoting the Christian life along the lines of the monastic ideal to which he was greatly devoted. His dogmatic and historical writings are almost all directed against every aspect of Arianism.
