



## RESPECT LIFE PARENT HEARTBREAK



Put yourself in the place of parents that have to watch as their child is euthanized before their eyes. MV, as named by the Canadian courts, is a 27-year-old autistic girl living with her parents. She is healthy in all other aspects but suffers

from the ADHD psychiatric disorder. The courts have approved her request for medically assisted suicide against the wishes of her parents.

MV will become part of the 2024 statistics. In 2022, over 13,000 Canadians were euthanized. This was up 31.2% from the previous year. The statistics for 2023 are still being compiled, but numbers look like they will easily exceed those of the past. With a 30% compound interest growth rate, it won't be long before numbers are huge.

Don't wait for this heartbreak to become a reality here in Florida.

Babies aborted this week: *Lily, Ashton, Noah, Astrid, and Raven*. Charlotte County residents, even without the Olean Boulevard abortion clinic there were 289 abortions in 2022. Please spiritually adopt one of these babies.

## GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION

#### **FOR CATHOLICS**

Catholics fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when they receive Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ's commandment to eat His Body and drink His Blood. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, communicants should not be conscious of grave sin, have fasted for an hour, and seek to live in charity and love with their neighbors. Persons conscious of grave sin must first be reconciled with God and the Church through the sacrament of Penance. A frequent reception of the sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

#### FOR OTHER CHRISTIANS

We welcome to this celebration of the Eucharist those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a consequence of the sad divisions in Christianity that we cannot extend to them a general invitation to receive Communion. Catholics believe that the Eucharist is an action of the celebrating community signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray.

## FOR THOSE NOT RECEIVING COMMUNION

Those not receiving sacramental Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with our Lord Jesus and with one another.

#### FOR NON-CHRISTIANS

We also welcome to this celebration those who do not share our faith in Jesus. While we cannot extend to them an invitation to receive Communion, we do invite them to be united with us in prayer.

## Catholic Declaration on Life and Death



The Catholic Declaration on Life and Death is a health care advance directive for Florida's Catholics and is approved by the Bishops of Florida. This directive conforms to both Florida law and the teaching of the Church.

#### What is an "advance directive"?

There are two forms of advance directives: the designation of **health care surrogate**, which authorizes a person to make decisions for the incapacitated patient, and the **living will**, which gives instructions to physicians and caregivers regarding medical care and treatment at the end of life. The Catholic Declaration on Life and Death merges both forms into one directive.

#### **BAPTISM**

Baptisms are celebrated on the last Saturday of the month. Parents should contact our Faith Formation Office at least six weeks before the anticipated Baptism to register for the Baptism preparation class at (941) 585-0668 or via email at faithformation@stcbc.org.

#### THE RITE OF ANOINTING

A person does not need to wait until the point of death to receive this sacrament. For those who are about to depart from this life, the Church offers the person Penance, Anointing of the Sick, and the Eucharist as Viaticum (food for the journey) given at the end of life. Contact the Parish Office at (941) 625-4754 to schedule an anointing.

#### **SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE**

If you are a registered parishioner of St. Charles Borromeo Church and plan to marry in our parish, please contact the Office of Faith Formation at (941) 585-0668 at least six months prior to the tentative wedding date.

#### **CONVALIDATION OF MARRIAGES**

Were you married outside of the Catholic Church? Don't hesitate to contact the Office of Faith Formation at (941) 585-0668 or faithformation@stcbc.org to make arrangements to have your marriage blessed by one of our priests.

#### **DIVORCED OR SEPARATED**



vehicle for transportation for school children from Arcadia and for school field trips.





New Beginnings Grief Support Group helps the bereaved understand the grief experience, process their grief, and move forward. The group members support each other and share insights with one another.


New Beginnings meets the second and fourth Tuesdays of every month from 2:00 PM to 3:30 PM in the Church choir room.

Our Respect Life Office is a great source of current and relevant information on the Life issues.




