The Latin words "spiritus" and "spirare" mean "breath" and "to breathe." It is how we get the word "spirit" and the name, "Holy Spirit," for it is the Spirit in us that gives us breath. When the Spirit came upon the disciples at Pentecost, they were undeniably changed and a force came through them that they recorded like a "strong driving wind." This enabled them to proclaim the good news in a way that was previously impossible.


7. COMPLETE A MARIAN CONSECRATION

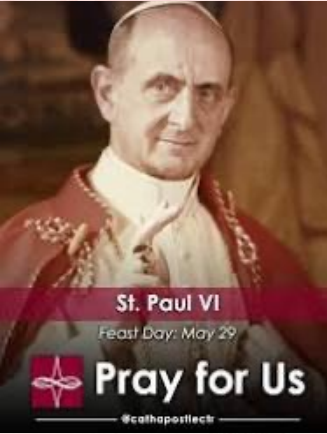
Saints of the Week



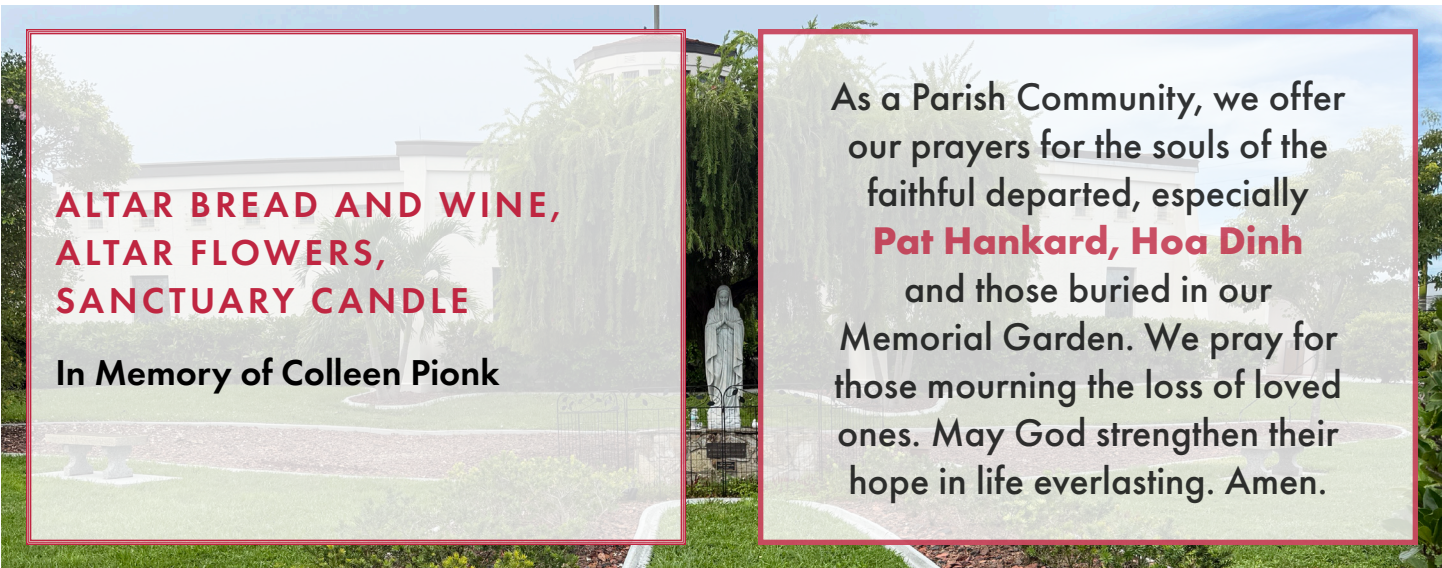
Saint Philip Neri (1515–1595), often called the “Apostle of Rome,” was an Italian priest famous for his infectious joy, humility, and radical hospitality. He is the patron saint of joy, humor, and laughter. He founded the Congregation of the Oratory, a community of secular priests focused on prayer and music. He is the patron of the US Army Special Forces (Green Berets) for his selfless leadership and teaching.



Saint Augustine of Canterbury (died c. 604) was a Benedictine monk who became the first Archbishop of Canterbury and is known as the “Apostle to the English”. He was sent from Rome by Pope Gregory the Great in 596 to convert the pagan Anglo-Saxons of Britain to Christianity and successfully converted King Athelberht of Kent, the first Anglo-Saxon king to embrace Christianity.



Saint Paul VI (1897–1978) was the head of the Catholic Church from 1963 to 1978. He successfully closed the Second Vatican Council in 1965 and began the complex work of implementing its modernizing reforms. He issued the landmark encyclical in 1968, which reaffirmed the Church’s teaching against artificial birth control. Also known as the “Pilgrim Pope,” he was the first reigning pontiff to travel by airplane and visit multiple continents, including North America and Asia. He was canonized as a saint by Pope Francis on October 14, 2018.
