Excerpts from Colleen Jurkiewicz Dorman's
"RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS."



The biggest mistake we can make as Christians is to think that the Resurrection is the end of the story. Of course we know, logically, that it isn't but sometimes we don't act like it. We like stories that can be tied up neatly in a bow. It's why "happily ever after" is a thing.

Look at Cleopas. He has heard the testimony of people he knew, people he trusted — and yet, he's in a world of confusion. He's stumbling along the road, wondering what to believe.

Christ gave us "happily ever after." But what do you do with "happily ever after?" What do you do with the Resurrection? What do you do with salvation?

The Resurrection left loose ends because it was not a final chapter. So being a Christian means embracing the life of a loose end. It means figuring out what to do with the Resurrection, with salvation, with forgiveness — with this hard-won "happily ever after" that is a gift but also a commission.

We are all characters in the **Greatest Story Ever Told**. So, what's the next scene?

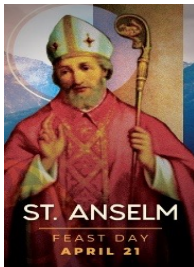

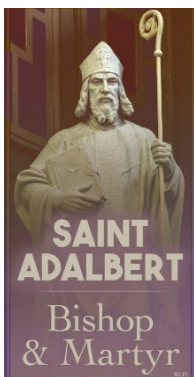
Saints of the Week



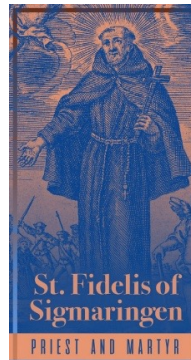
Saint Anselm of Canterbury, was a Benedictine monk who as a Doctor of the Church is celebrated for his attempts to prove the truths of faith through reason. He wrote that, "I do not seek to understand in order that I may believe, but I believe in order to understand."



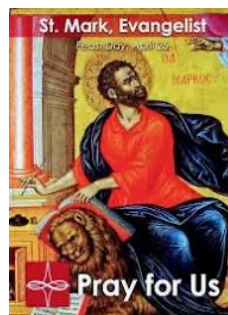
Saint George (died c. 303) was a Roman military officer of Greek descent who was martyred for his faith in Palestine. Known as a "warrior saint," he is the patron saint of England, Georgia, and Catalonia. Legend, popularized in the 12th century, depicts him rescuing a princess by slaying a dragon, symbolizing the triumph of good over evil. He was martyred by Emperor Diocletian after refusing to participate in the persecution of Christians and declaring his own faith.



Saint Adalbert of Prague (c. 956–997) was a Bohemian Bishop and missionary who evangelized the pagans in Hungary, Poland, and Prussia before his martyrdom on April 23, 997. As a patron saint of the Czech Republic and Poland, he is remembered for his reformist efforts and fearless preaching. A Polish prince famously ransomed his remains for their weight in gold, placing them in the Cathedral Basilica of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Adalbert in Gniezno. His feast day is April 23.



Saint Fidelis of Sigmaringen (1577–1622) was a German Capuchin friar and the first martyr of the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples. Known as the "Poor Man's Lawyer," he is the patron saint of lawyers and jurists. He was renowned for his integrity and for representing those who could not afford legal fees. Disgusted by the corruption in the legal system, he joined the Capuchin branch of the Franciscans in 1612, taking the name Fidelis (meaning "faithful"). During the Counter-Reformation, he was sent to Switzerland to preach to Calvinists. While preaching he was attacked by a mob of Calvinist soldiers after refusing to renounce the Catholic faith. His final words included a prayer for his attackers: "Lord, forgive my enemies."



Mark the Evangelist is primarily known as the author of the Gospel of Mark. As a key early church figure, he was a traveling companion to Paul and Barnabas and later, a close companion and interpreter to St. Peter in Rome. The Gospel of Mark emphasizes Jesus as the suffering Son of God and focuses on His ministry rather than His birth. Represented by the symbol of a winged lion, Mark is the patron saint of many places, most famously Venice, Italy, where his remains are believed to be interred. He was martyred in Alexandria, Egypt, around 68 AD. His feast day is April 25.

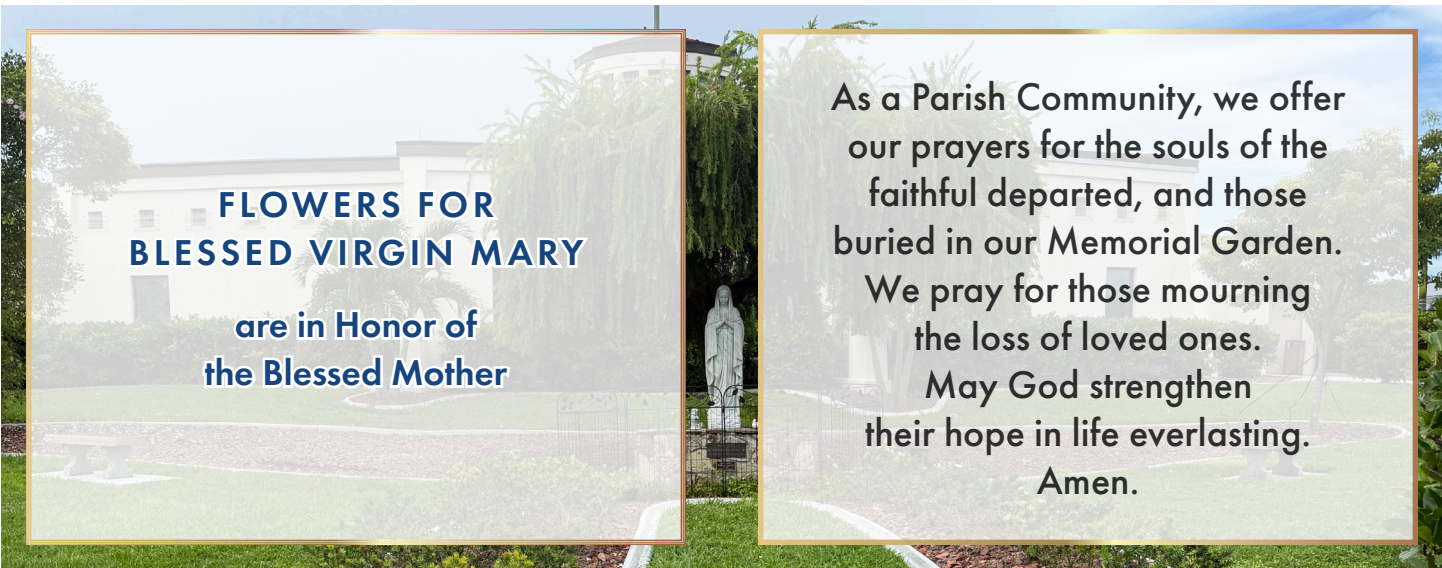


