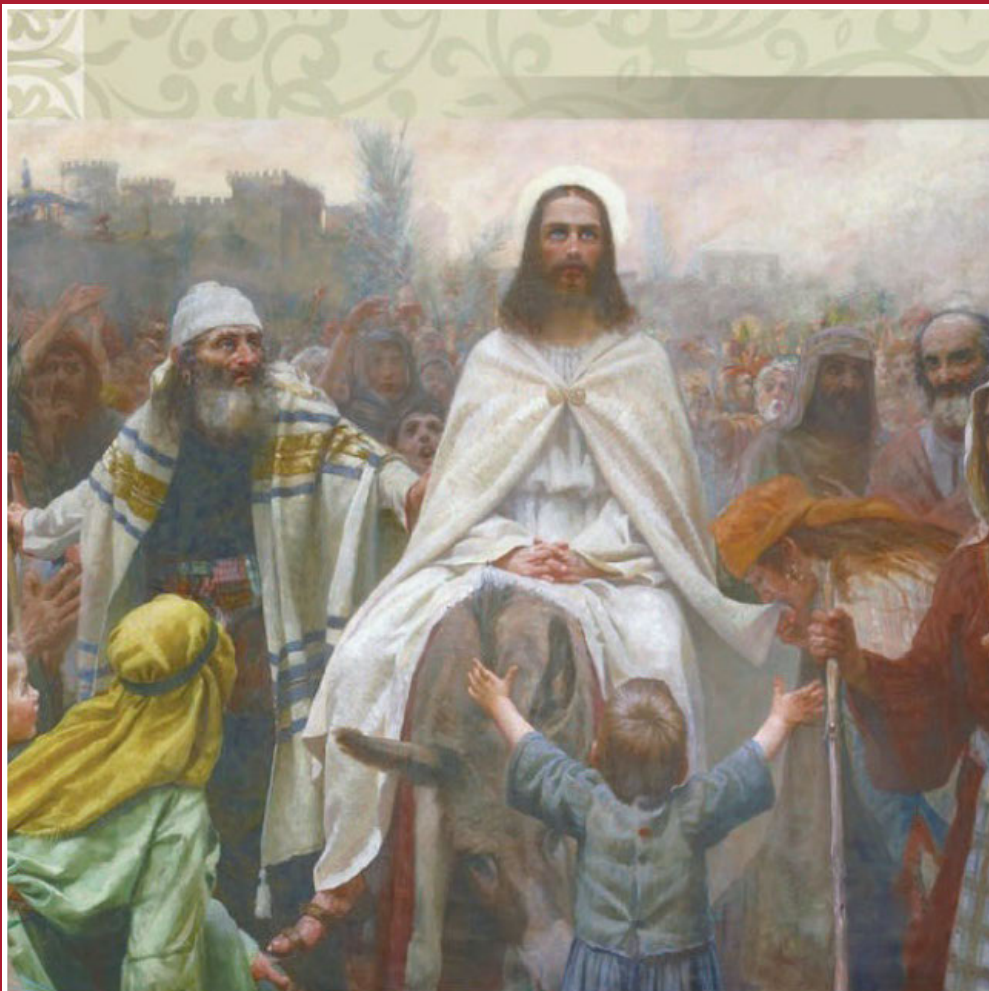

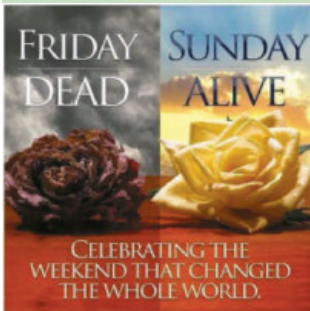

## ALTAR BREAD & WINE

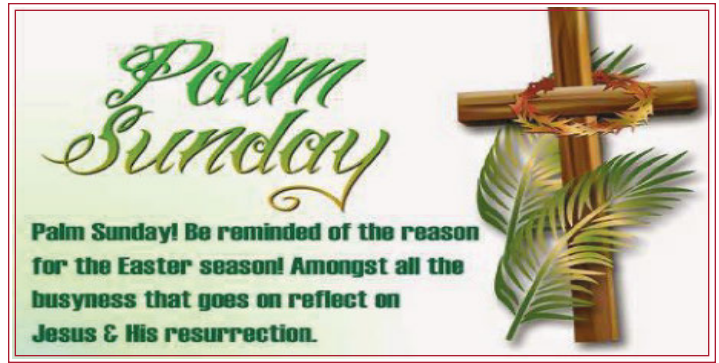

# How to Pray The Chaplet of Divine Mercy

1. Make the Sign of the Cross

2. (Optional\*) Pray,

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelope the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!

3. "Our Father,"

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Amen.

"Hail Mary,"

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

"The Apostles' Creed."

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead....

...I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

4. On the Our Father beads pray,

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

5. On the Hail Mary Beads pray,

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

6. Pray three times,

4. Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

(Optional\*)

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.

Close with the Sign of the Cross.

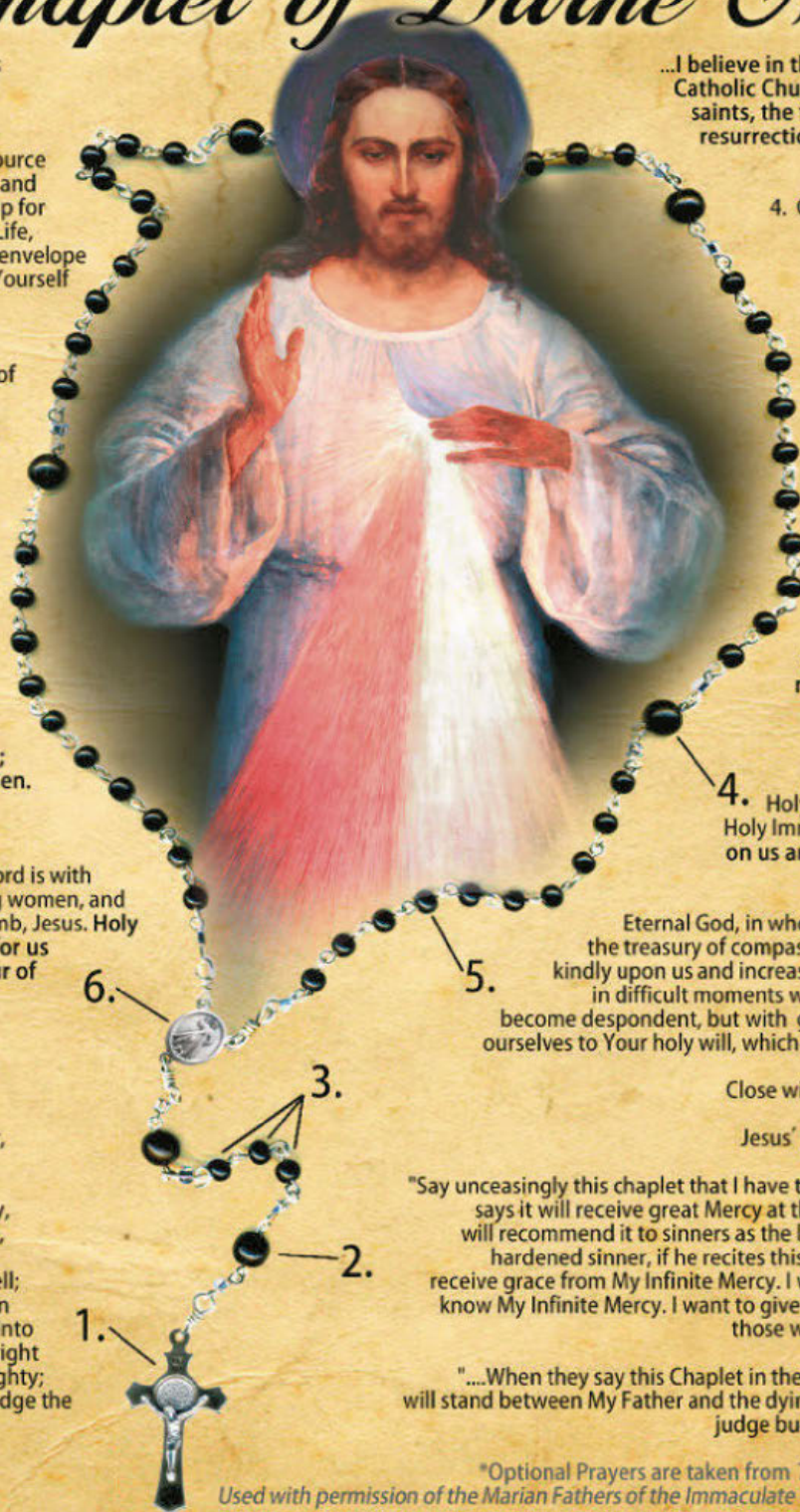
Jesus' promise to St. Faustina:

"Say unceasingly this chaplet that I have taught you. Anyone who says it will receive great Mercy at the hour of death. Priests will recommend it to sinners as the last hope. Even the most hardened sinner, if he recites this Chaplet even once, will receive grace from My Infinite Mercy. I want the whole world to know My Infinite Mercy. I want to give unimaginable graces to those who trust in My Mercy...."

"...When they say this Chaplet in the presence of the dying, I will stand between My Father and the dying person not as the just judge but as the Merciful Savior."

## DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

Join us Friday, April 18<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup>

A novena is nine days of prayer in preparation for a celebration of a feast day. Though the Chaplet of Divine Mercy Novena can be recited at any time, it is best recited at 3:00 PM because it is the Hour of Great Mercy. On February 22, 1931, Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ appeared to St. Faustina with rays radiating from His heart and gave her a message for humanity. On September 13, 1935, she had another vision. A day later, an inner voice asked her to pray this prayer on ordinary Rosary beads. This chaplet is known as Divine Mercy Chaplet. It is so powerful that priests recommend it to sinners as the last hope. Even if recited once, a sinner receives grace from Our Lord. The Novena has prayers for each of the nine days, praying to God on behalf of different people each day, in addition to saying the Chaplet.

The Novena begins immediately following the Passion/Veneration/Communion on Good Friday and continues each day at 3:00 PM in the Church, ending on Saturday, April 26<sup>th</sup>. The Divine Mercy Chaplet will also be prayed at 3:00 PM on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 27<sup>th</sup>.



## *Behold the Lamb of Eucharistic Amazement*

### **A Parish Lenten Mission**

**Sunday, April 13<sup>th</sup> - Tuesday, April 15<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM**

#### **Day 1 - In Memoriam: The Wolf And The Lamb Will Lie Down Together (Is. 11:6)**

This reflection highlights the historical and spiritual progression through time and into the deeper holiness that culminates in our reception of the Holy Eucharist at Mass. Joy is essential for holiness. Various true-life stories are given in this talk to highlight the fact that not only is God alone able to give us the spiritual gift of Joy. He desires to do so far more than we could ever ask or imagine!!

#### **Day 2 - Agnus Dei: Like A Gentle Lamb Led To The Slaughter (Jer. 11:19)**

The world is suffering immensely today – yes, physically, but even more so psychologically. This reflection is a study on psychological afflictions of our world today. It highlights the reality of our fallen nature as we remain in essential need of the One Perfect Love who is Jesus Christ Whom we receive in each Holy Communion. The talk is interjected with powerful stories of inspiration taken from contemporary Eucharistic holiness.

#### **Day 3 - Mary, Mother of the Eucharist: “I Watched As The Lamb Opened The First Of Seven Seals... ‘Come!’” (Rev. 6:1)**

In his own admission, the irrepressible 20th century apologist, poet, and philosopher, G.K. Chesterton, once said: “When I think of the power of woman, my knees knock under me.” If this sentiment is understood of women in general because of their unswerving, maternal dedication to those they love, how much more so should we venerate the mother of God whose love brought Divinity to share in our humanity! She is Christ’s mother and, as of Good Friday, 33 A.D., she is our mother too!

## OBITUARIES, 33 AD

Jesus Christ, 33, of Nazareth, died Friday on Mount Calvary, also known as the place of the skull.

Betrayed by the Apostle Judas, Jesus was crucified by the Romans, by order of the Ruler Pontius Pilate. The causes of death were crucifixion, asphyxiation, severe torture, and loss of blood. Jesus Christ, a descendant of Abraham, was a member of the house of David. He was the Son of the late Joseph, a carpenter of Nazareth, and Mary, His devoted Mother. Jesus was born in a stable in the city of Bethlehem, Judea. He is survived by His mother Mary, His apostles, numerous disciples, and many other followers. Jesus was self-educated and spent the latter part of His life working as a Teacher. Jesus also occasionally worked as a Medical Doctor and it is reported that He healed many patients. Up until the time of His death, Jesus was teaching and sharing the Good News, healing the sick, loving the lonely, feeding the hungry, and helping the poor. Jesus was most noted for telling parables about His Father's Kingdom and performing miracles, such as feeding over 5,000 people with only five loaves of bread and two fish, and healing a man who was born blind. On the day before His death, He held a Last Supper celebrating the Passover Feast, at which He foretold His death. The body was quickly buried in a stone grave, which was donated by Joseph of Arimathea, a loyal friend of the family. By order of Pontius Pilate, a boulder was rolled in front of the tomb; Roman soldiers were put on guard. In lieu of flowers, the family has requested that everyone try to live as Jesus did.

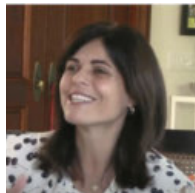
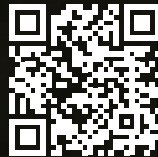

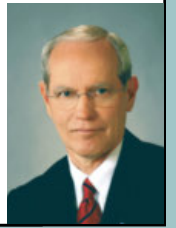
