



The Annunciation of the Lord

(March 25) commemorates the Archangel Gabriel's announcement to the Virgin Mary that she would conceive Jesus by the Holy Spirit. Celebrated nine months before Christmas, this solemnity marks the Incarnation — the moment God became human — and honors Mary's "yes" (fiat) to God's plan.

EXAMINATION OF CONSCIENCE

Recall your sins. Calmly and honestly, ask yourself with the help of the Holy Spirit what you have done with full knowledge and full consent against God and the Church's commandments.

- Do I pray to God every day? Have I thanked God for His gifts to me?
- Did I put my faith in danger through reading material that is hostile to Catholic teachings? Have I been involved in non-Catholic sects? Did I engage in superstitious practices, such as palm reading or fortune telling?
- Did I take the name of God in vain? Did I curse, or take a false oath?
- Did I miss Mass on Sundays or holy days of obligation through my own fault?
- Am I attentive at Mass? Did I fast and abstain on the prescribed days?
- Did I disobey my parents or lawful superiors in important matters?
- Did I hate or quarrel with anyone, or desire revenge? Did I refuse to forgive? Was I disrespectful?
- Did I get drunk? Did I take illicit drugs? Did I consent to, recommend, advise, or actively take part in an abortion?
- Did I willfully look at indecent pictures, watch immoral movies, or read immoral books or magazines? Did I engage in impure jokes or conversations? Did I willfully entertain impure thoughts or commit impure acts, alone or with others? Did I use artificial means to prevent conception?
- Did I steal or damage another's property? Have I been honest in my business relations?
- Did I tell lies? Did I sin by gossiping about others? Did I judge others rashly in serious matters?
- Have I envied other people?


What you will experience is the healing gift of God's love, the chance to start over with a clean conscience, and an overwhelming sense of gratitude.

Flower Memorials may also be purchased online at www.stcharlespc.org (under Second Collections) and in the Parish Office until Holy Thursday.



The St. Charles Funeral Ministry


is seeking additional volunteers — especially *men* — to assist at funeral Masses and burials.

Saint of the Week



Saint Turibius of Mogrovejo (1538–1606) was a Spanish missionary and the second Archbishop of Lima, Peru. He is celebrated as a reformer, a champion of indigenous rights, and a pioneer of the Catholic Church in the New World. His archdiocese was massive—covering over 180,000 square miles

across much of South America. Turibius founded the first seminary in the Americas in 1591. He famously challenged Spanish colonial authorities and clergy over their mistreatment and oppression of the native people, insisting on their human dignity.

Catholic Virtues



Self-Control

Self-control flows from the cardinal virtue of temperance, and it's really all about boundaries. Passions only become problematic when we allow them to control us. Through self-control, a gift of the Holy Spirit, we avoid surrendering too much of ourselves to our passions. "When regulated by reason, and subjected to the control of the will, the passions may be considered good and used as means of acquiring and exercising virtue," we read in *The Catholic Encyclopedia*. "The sensitive is given to man by God, and therefore its acts have to be employed in His service."

Through retreats, theological formation, and spiritual direction, the Office helps men and women explore their vocation with clarity and faith. By fostering a culture of vocations within Parishes and Schools, the next generation of servant leaders is inspired.



Seminarians embark on a journey of spiritual, academic, personal, and pastoral formation. This path is not only rigorous but costs in excess of \$75,000 annually per seminarian. Your gift helps to ensure that financial burdens do not stand in the way of a vocation. The Diocese has **15 seminarians** who are enrolled in their respective levels of academic formation. During the summer, the seminarians assist in Parishes, instruct the young, pray with the Community of the Faithful, and gain valuable pastoral experience.



The Diocese is blessed to have **Religious Sisters** who willingly devote their lives to prayer, service, and compassion as they quietly transform communities through faith education, healthcare where necessary, and spiritual assistance. The **Permanent Diaconate**, a vocation in the Catholic Church which allows men, including those who are married, to be ordained as Deacons to serve both at the altar and in the community.
