Offertory Collection at St. Charles that we are able to continue to provide you with the precious gift of beautiful liturgies.

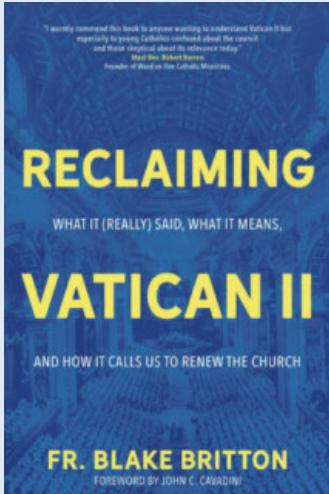

GUIDELINES FOR RECEIVING COMMUNION

FOR CATHOLICS

Catholics fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist when they receive Holy Communion in fulfillment of Christ's commandment to eat His Body and drink His Blood. In order to be properly disposed to receive Communion, communicants should not be conscious of grave sin, have fasted for an hour, and seek to live in charity and love with their neighbors. Persons conscious of grave sin must first be reconciled with God and the Church through the sacrament of Penance. A frequent reception of the sacrament of Penance is encouraged for all.

FOR OTHER CHRISTIANS

We welcome to this celebration of the Eucharist those Christians who are not fully united with us. It is a consequence of the sad divisions in Christianity that we cannot extend to them a general invitation to receive Communion. Catholics believe that the Eucharist is an action of the celebrating community signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. Reception of the Eucharist by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray.

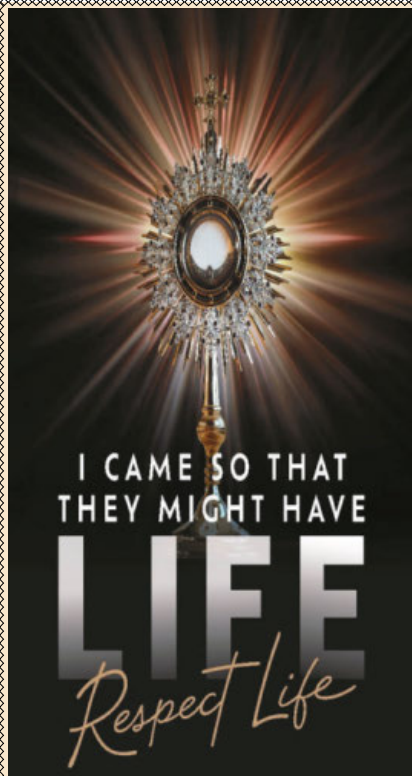
FOR THOSE NOT RECEIVING COMMUNION

Those not receiving sacramental Communion are encouraged to express in their hearts a prayerful desire for unity with our Lord Jesus and with one another.

FOR NON-CHRISTIANS

We also welcome to this celebration those who do not share our faith in Jesus. While we cannot extend to them an invitation to receive Communion, we do invite them to be united with us in prayer.

RESPECT LIFE JUSTIN OR JUSTICE

As country leadership in the USA changes, so does leadership in our Northern neighbor. Justin Trudeau resigned as head of the Canadian government on January 6. His leadership of Canada's liberal party began in 2013, and he assumed government leadership in 2015. During his tenure, abortions stayed steady at nearly 100,000 per year, and euthanasia was legalized in 2016. Almost 45,000 Canadians have died by suicide with government approval since then. The pace increases by 30 % each year. (www.cbc.ca)

Do recent political changes signal a return to earlier times? Will we begin to value the family, the rights of individuals, and the universal right to life? Certainly, it is too soon to know. Personally, I would be thrilled to see Christians, especially Catholics, lead this change by insisting that every candidate must respect those rights before earning a vote.

Abortions dropped in Florida during 2024 since the heartbeat bill became law in May, but we still see too many early medical abortions. Please spiritually adopt *Lucas, Juniper, and Noah*.
