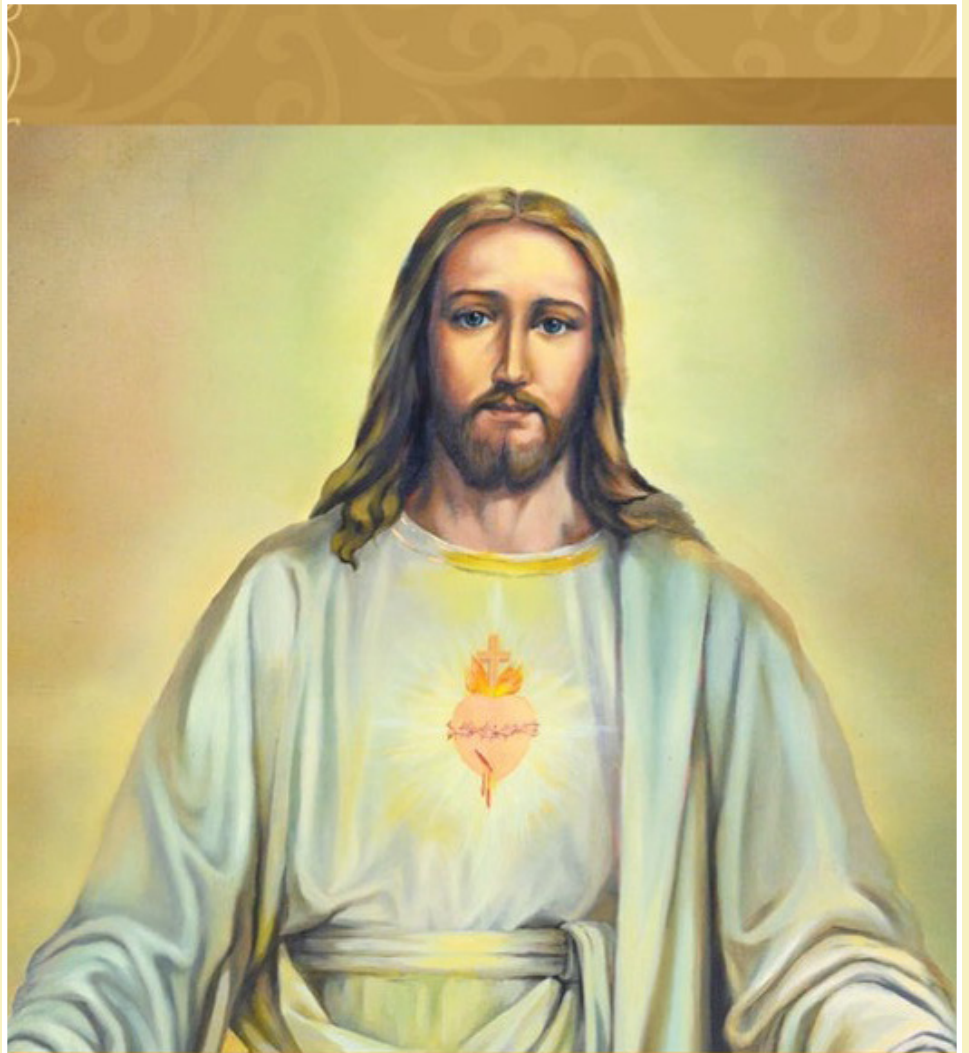

May is the Month of Mary

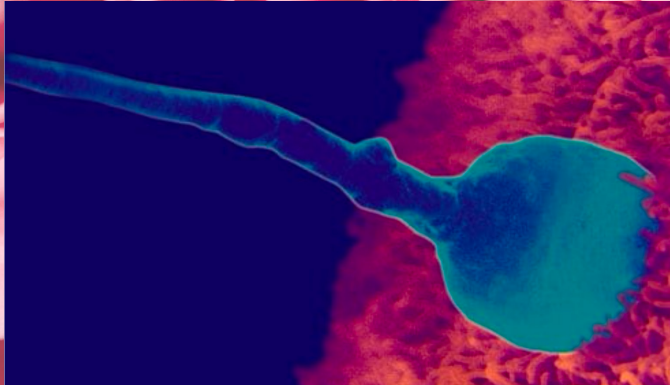
During the month of May, we will pray the **Holy Rosary** every Monday at **6:30 PM** in the Church.

TIPS TO PRAY THE ROSARY EVERY DAY

- Fall asleep praying the Rosary. It is better than counting sheep.
- Say it in moments of sadness or spiritual drought.
- If you can't pray a whole Rosary at once, break it into parts.
- Carry a Rosary in your pocket.
- Use each mystery to ask for a particular intention.
- Say it while you wait (for example, at the bus stop).
- Pray while you walk and think of the people in your life.
- Recite the Rosary while doing chores or while you work out.
- Use images and music. The Rosary is a contemplative prayer.
- If you're upset, pray for the situation that worries you.

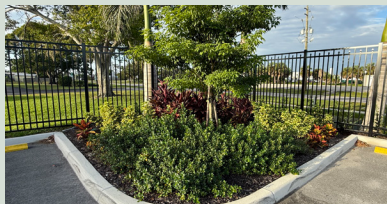

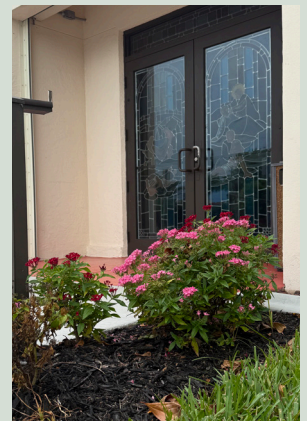

Catholic Faith Appeal

For several weeks you have read about the many services that are funded by the Catholic Faith Appeal. There are additional Administrative Offices that are also funded by the CFA.

One of these is the Offices of the Bishop for the Diocese of Venice, led by Bishop Frank J. Dewane. It serves as the central administrative and spiritual authority for approximately 250,000 Catholics across 10 counties in Florida.

The office fulfills three primary functions:

- **Teaching:** The Bishop acts as the principal teacher of the faith, ensuring sound doctrine is preached in parishes and schools.
- **Governing:** This involves overseeing the administration of the Diocese, managing finances, and setting policies for church property and personnel.
- **Sanctifying:** The Bishop is the primary dispenser of sacraments; he ordains priests and deacons and travels throughout the Diocese to perform Confirmations.

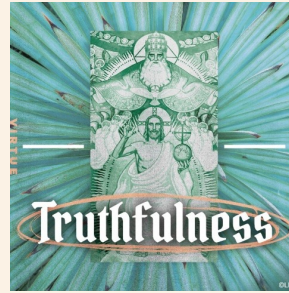

Sin began with a lie.

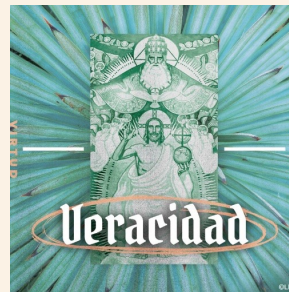


It was a lie that Satan told Eve in the Garden of Eden, and it was by doubting God's faithfulness — by thinking God to be a liar — that the fall of man came about.

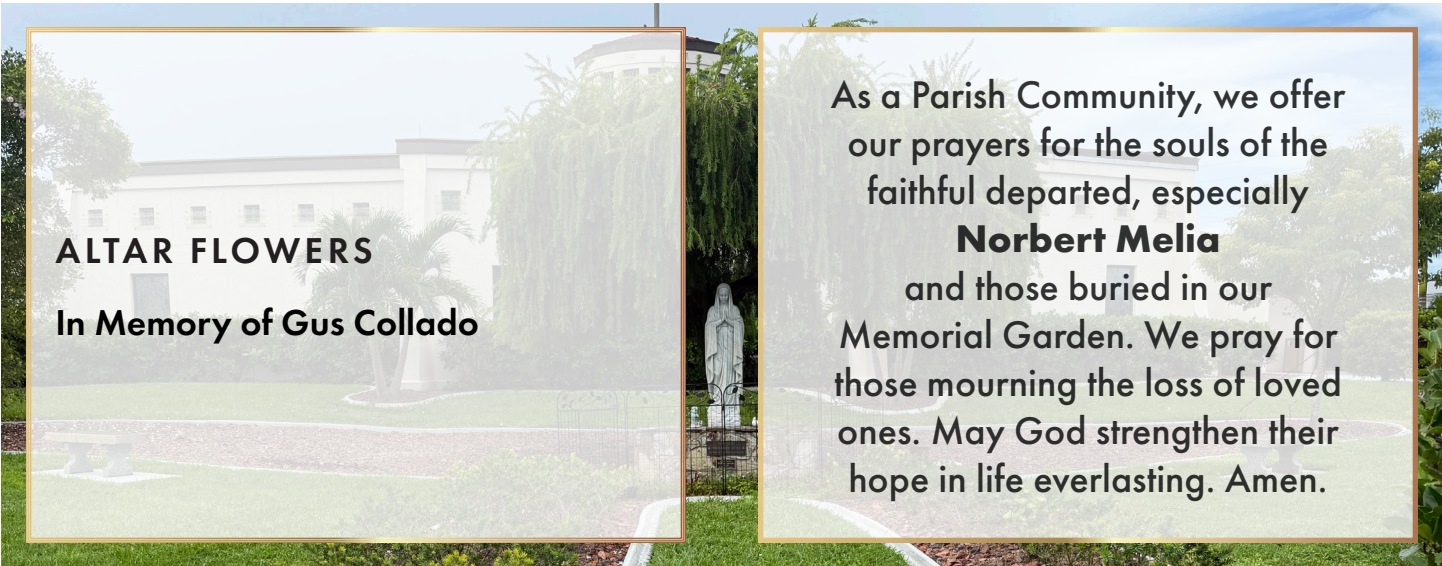




